Cookies				
What are cookies and how does BCP Global use them?	Cookies are files or information that can be stored on your devices when you visit websites or use online services. BCP Global utilizes cookies to facilitate the use and experience of the website and applications to the interests and needs of the users, as well as to assist and improve its structures and content. Types of Cookies				
Necessary	Necessary cookies are essential for the website to function properly. These cookies ensure basic functionalities and security features of the website. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but doing so may prevent parts of the website from working correctly.			
Functional	Functional cookies allow the website to remember your choices and thus offer a customized experience. They also allow users to watch videos, use social media, fields for comments, forums, among others.			
Performance	Performance cookies help understand how visitors interact with the website. Information is collected about the visited areas, the time spent, and any problems encountered, with its error messages. We use Google Analytics to monitor the traffic and to measure and improve the website's performance.			
Marketing	Marketing cookies are used to offer more relevant and interesting content to the user. They can present advertising with better targeting or limit the quantity shown on the website pages. Also allowing to measure the effectiveness of an advertising campaign.			

Third Party Cookies

Third Party Cookies are transferred to your device by an authorized third party. We have no control over the cookies set by other sites that you visit, even if you are directed to them from our site. However, we may work with certain third-party providers, such as Google or Facebook, to allow their cookies to work through our website, enabling the organization to provide you with a better experience and personalized services on our website.
